Why is an Understanding of Worldview Important?

We live in a culture that is radically different from what it was even two or three generations ago. Our society has changed from one that was based upon Christian worldview principles, to one that is now very pluralistic and can legitimately be characterized as post-Christian.

Added to that, it is clear that there is a great deal of confusion within the Christian community itself. That confusion relates not only to the inability of believers to fully understand the problems we face in our culture, but also to a lack of understanding about how to deal with those problems. It is worldview concepts that give us the tools we need to grapple with these issues.

What Is the Issue MarketFaith Ministries Is Trying to Address?

MarketFaith Ministries was created to help Christians understand this anti-Christian storm, and provide training about how to stand strong as faithful witnesses for Christ in the midst of it.

Modern Christians face a huge problem in attempting to understand the root cause of our society's current drift away from Christ. What we have is a clash of worldviews that, in the 1960s and 1970s, tipped decidedly in favor of Secularism. That trend has only accelerated since that time. Unfortunately, virtually all institutions of modern society (politics, entertainment, education, news media, business, family, and even many churches) are now dominated by non-Christian worldview beliefs.

There are many organizations, including some Christian ministries, that are working to positively influence the culture by engaging these societal institutions. As important as this is, it is not enough; individual Christians must somehow be engaged in the process. The purpose of

MarketFaith Ministries is to give believers the tools they need to more actively express Christ in the world. We believe that worldview discipleship training has the greatest potential to actually make this a reality.

Serving God out in the world is the "grunt work" of Christian ministry. To do this kind of work, everyday Christians must get down in the trenches and express Christ in their world. Without this, the church will fail in its mission! Pastors generally have the opportunity to get in-depth training at a seminary or Bible school to learn to do the work of ministry. But where is the average Christian going to have that kind of possibility? The only logical place is the local church.



Unfortunately, most churches simply don't have the resources to get at this effectively. The result is what has already been described – a culture that is drifting ever further away from God. A powerful solution to this problem is a ministry dedicated to helping the church in this arena. That is the calling of *MarketFaith Ministries*.

What we Teach

A worldview is a set of beliefs – but not just any beliefs. It is the beliefs people hold that help them distinguish between reality and fantasy. Sadly, there are billions of people in the world that are completely convinced that what they believe is real – when, in fact, it is not. Our Christian faith is true reality, and Christians need to be able to express their faith in a way that bridges that gap.

The 4 Categories of Training We Share

MarketFaith Ministries has a very specific worldview discipleship curriculum that we share. We have broken it down into four areas.

1. What is Worldview?

Worldview concepts are based on a missionary paradigm. In previous generations, average American Christians did not need this kind of specialized knowledge. But in our increasingly pluralistic society, it has become a necessity.

Most Christians are familiar with the basics of Christian doctrine. Our training puts this in the context of a worldview paradigm. This gives believers the tools to understand their own faith in a way that allows them to compare it with other faiths, and to see why ours is the truth.

3. Worldview and the Christian Life

A Christian worldview uniquely expresses itself in the daily life of a Christian. This training helps believers see clearly how biblical worldview beliefs must play out in the Christian life.

4. Worldview and Your Witness

A worldview paradigm provides a method for understanding every faith system in existence – our own as well as others. This training gives believers the tools to share their faith across worldview barriers.
